



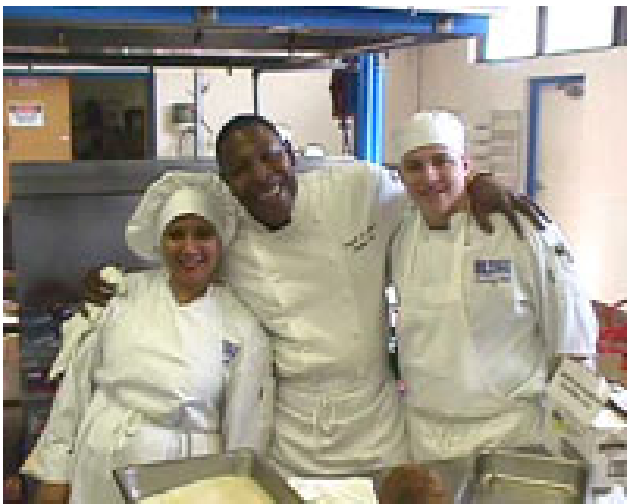
WHAT'S COOKING AT MTI
